- Residence Hall charges are posted per semester and are due in full the first day of classes
- Kenilworth charges are posted for per semester, but they can be paid either in full or per month

#### **Meal Plans**

- Meal plans are a set amount of money loaded onto your Panther ID each semester based on the level you purchase
  - \$1 = 1 meal plan point
- The cost of a meal plan includes the meal plan points and the admin fee
- Using a meal plan can yield approximately 50% off in the cafeteria dining facilities in University Housing (Cambridge Café, Sandburg Café, Palm Gardens) and at select restaurants in the Union
- Meal plans are not required in Sandburg East, Cambridge Commons Upgrades, Purin, and Kenilworth as these all offer full-sized kitchens in the suite
  - Students who live in Cambridge Commons Upgrades and East Tower who opt out of the meal plan are still required to pay the admin fee

"The Standard Plan (Level 2) is the default level if a meal plan is not selected or if assigned to a building that requires a meal plan but "No Plan" was selected in the contract process.

"Residents of Cambridge Commons Upgrades and Sandburg East Tower are required to pay the administrative fee to cover facility use, even if "No Plan" was selected in the contract process.

(Permanent residents of Purin Hall may opt out of 100% of the meal plan, as there is no cafeteria provided in that building.)



# **On-Campus Housing**

- Anyone who is enrolled in a minimum of 6 credits is eligible to live on-campus
- Contract Access:
  - All newly admitted students and majority of new transfer students under the age of 21 are automatically provided access to the Residence Hall Contract
  - Kenilworth contracts are typically provided upon request to student. As space is available, we will do a
    larger release to those 21 years of age or older that are newly admitted, or new transfer admits.
- Residence Halls (Sandburg Towers, Cambridge Commons, RiverView and Purin) are all on one contract. Kenilworth has its own contract.

## **Step 1: Accessing Your Contract**

- Once a contract is available for you to submit, you will receive an email
  - This email will include instructions and the deadline to submit your contract
- Your contract is in your My Housing Portal (<u>uwm.edu/myhousing</u>)
- You must enter an emergency contact before you can access your contract

## **Step 2: Submitting Your Contract**

- You will have form fields to respond to online:
  - You will be asked for your immunization history on Hepatitis B and Meningococcal vaccines
  - These immunizations are **not** required to live in University Housing
- You will enter preferences for us to best assign you to a room such as:
  - Top three room/building preferences (ex: Sandburg Single, Cambridge Double, etc.)
  - LLC preference (optional)
  - Roommate preferences
  - Lifestyle habits (stay up late vs get up early, noise preferences, study habits, etc.)
- You will also select your meal plan level in the contract
- Once you submit your contract, you will receive a confirmation email



# **Step 3: Paying Your Deposit**

- Once your contract is submitted, the housing deposit will be posted to your PAWS account
  - The deposit for the Residence Halls is \$100
  - The deposit for Kenilworth is \$300
- Deposit payments can be made online in PAWS
  - Log into PAWS
  - In the middle section of your portal, there is a section titled "Finances"
  - At the bottom of the box is a link that says "make a payment"
  - Clicking that link will direct you to the Bursars Office's payment portal
- Payments can also be made via wire transfer
- For any questions regarding making payments, please reach out to the Bursars Office





# Step 4: Receiving Your Room Assignment

- We will release housing assignments for Spring 2022 the week of January 3, 2022.
- Once you have been assigned to a room, you will receive an email with instructions on how to see your room assignment, roommate, suitemates, and move-in appointment.
- Your housing assignment will be available in your MyHousing Portal where you submitted your contract.

If you were, or still are a minor, who submitted your Contract online, the Contract Signature Page form (www.uwm.edu/hous withheld until contracts terms have been co-signed by legal parent or guardian, or yourself at the point you turn 1!

Room Assignment: housing assignments started to be posted to student MyHousing accounts the afternoon of Friday July details and move-in details. If a student was not provided an assignment on July 9, they should also check their UWM e-mail As a reminder, to receive a room assignment your Contract deposit must be paid in full, or the non-refundable portion paid if Contract online, you are also required to submit the Minor Contract Signature page, linked above. Students use their MyHo move-in appointment.



### **Step 5: Prepare For Move-In**

#### Packing:

- What to pack: <a href="https://uwm.edu/housing/policies/move-in/items-to-bring/">https://uwm.edu/housing/policies/move-in/items-to-bring/</a>
- University Housing does not provide linens, dishware, cookware, cleaning supplies, etc.
- You may purchase items ahead of time (Walmart, Target, Amazon, etc.) and have them sent to your building no earlier than one week prior to move-in
- You can also purchase through On Campus Marketing (OCM) who partners with University Housing's Student Housing Administrative Council online

#### **Move-In Appointment:**

- The designated move-in dates for Spring 2022 are January 22-23
- If you need to arrive early, please submit an Early Arrival Request \*\* DEADLINE: January 1st
  - Requested arrivals must be between January 15 and January 21
- Additional nightly fees will be assessed based on how many additional days are needed
- University Housing does not provide temporary housing for non-contract holders prior to move-in. We
  encourage those needing temporary housing to explore local lodging options



### Step 6: Move-In



Upon your arrival to your assigned building, please check-in at the service desk to receive your move-in packet




When checking in, you will need to provide a photo ID or your Panther ID



There will be yellow carts available for loading your belongings to your room



If you have any friends, family, etc. who would like to help, you are allowed to have 2 non-University Housing residents assist with your move-in.



#### **COVID-19 Information**

- UWM's response to traveling internationally:
  - Unless things change, all non-US residents coming to US are required proof of being fully vaccinated and will not require quarantine.
    - Get tested with a COVID-19 viral test 3-5 days after travel.
    - Find a U.S. COVID-19 testing location near \*you
    - Self-monitor for <u>COVID-19 symptoms</u>; <u>isolate</u> and get tested if you develop symptoms.
    - Follow all <u>state and local</u> recommendations or requirements after travel.
- University Housing will provide isolation/quarantine spaces to students as requested.
   Students are required to report their need to quarantine to uh-adminassist@uwm.edu
- Masks must be worn when students are not in their assigned living space.



#### **COVID-19 Information**

- Students are required to inform University Housing if they have a requirement to quarantine.
- Email Address: <u>uh-adminassist@uwm.edu</u>
- The email should include:
  - Your name
  - 9-digit ID # (99x-xx-xxxx)
  - The date you will arrive to UWM University Housing
  - State that you have a need to quarantine as an international traveler
- University Housing will provide a temporary assignment for the duration of the 10-day (or seven days with a negative test result) quarantine period, as well as instructions as to when they can move into their permanent assignment.
- Masks must be worn when students are not in their assigned living space.
- How do I become exempt from testing/quarantine?
  - Students, faculty, and staff who are fully vaccinated and do not have symptoms of COVID-19 can get an exemption from quarantine requirements by completing this form\*\*. Please note that someone is considered to be fully vaccinated two weeks after receiving their final vaccine dose. Proof of vaccination is required, which could be a copy of the vaccination card.



## Requesting Exemption

- Per the UW System Policy, University Housing is required for all first-year freshman at UWM under the age of 21
- To learn more about requesting an exemption from the residency requirement, please see the <u>Residency Policy Toolkit</u>
- If you would like to request an exemption, please submit the <u>Exemption Request Form</u>\* and submit any required supporting documentation for review
- Upon receiving your exemption request, our staff will review it to determine if the documentation warrants a granted exemption. Decision letters or further information request will be sent to you via email.
